BEFORE INSTALLING

INSTALLATION

- 1. Remove the rubber pad from the end of the doorstop. **Tip:** Use a flat tool, such as a putty knife, to pry the pad loose.
- 2. Place the doorstop in its desired location. Note the small pin on the base of the doorstop, which is used to prevent the doorstop from loosening itself after installation. Use a hammer to strike the doorstop into the baseboard until the pin sets.
- 3. While holding the doorstop in place, insert a pencil into the end of the doorstop and mark the location of the mounting hole on the baseboard. Once marked, set the doorstop aside.
- 4. Drill a small pilot hole into the baseboard at the marked installation location.
- 5. Insert the supplied mounting screw into the doorstop, so that it passes through the mounting hole on the base.
- 6. Place the doorstop back into position at its installation location. Guide the mounting screw into the pilot hole drilled in step 4, then use a flathead screwdriver to tighten. Ensure that the pin fits back into its impression that was made in step 2.
- 7. Once the doorstop is installed, reattach the rubber pad to the end of the doorstop. Use a hammer if necessary.
